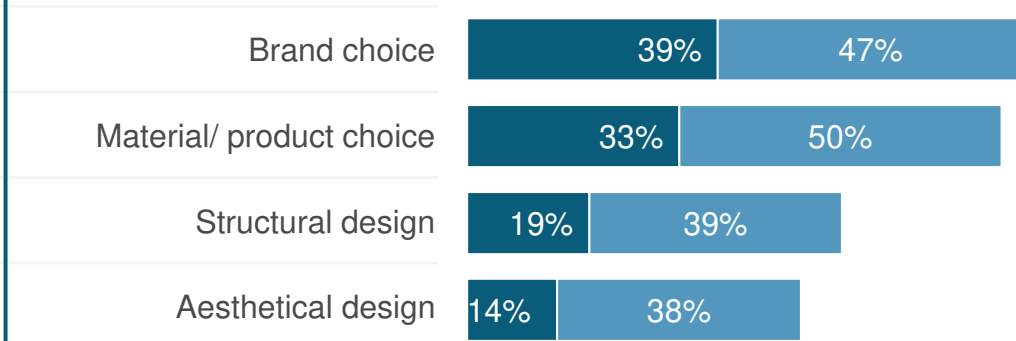


Why this report:

Decision involvement in brand choice



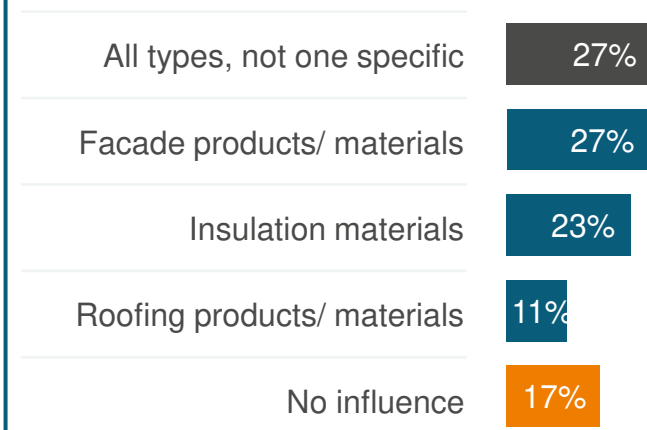

The highest decision involvement



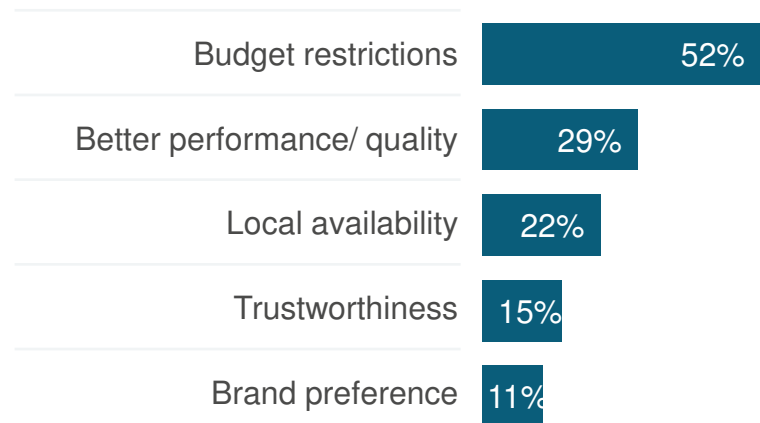
Spain

Key research topics:

- Turnover and orderbook developments of contractors
- Expectations of the effect of COVID-19 on 2020 turnover of contractors
- Project segmentation of contractors (residential, non-residential, new-build, renovation)
- Type of company (developer vs. non-developer) and contracts (traditional vs. design-build)
- Organization of activities/ services (architectural, engineering and installation)
- Decision making involvement in the design process, product and brand specifications by type of company (developer vs. non-developer)

Countries covered in the report:

The United Kingdom, Germany, France, Poland, Spain, Italy, Belgium and the Netherlands.

Methodology:

The report is based on 950 successful telephone interviews with contractors in 8 countries.
